What is An Insured Event?



Active Assailant Event

A malicious act, involving the use of force or violence, of any person or groups of persons who is armed with a firearm, bladed weapon, blunt force weapon, land conveyance, including a vehicle, drone or unmanned aerial device, explosive device, acid or corrosive substance, any of which prevent the insured from conducting their normal operations, and which physically harms any person present at the location.



Threat Incident

Any specific threats to inflict bodily injury or damage, destroy, or contaminate property.
